With the addition of our One Health subsidiary, we recognized the need to expand our parking and grounds to accommodate the increate in usage. On January 11, Collins Asphalt LLC began the work of clearing the landscape between the Administration building, and the existing blacktop of the Herschel R. Brown Vocational Center. Over the next two weeks, the skilled tradesmen cleared trees and hauled away debris. The next step was to level the area, followed by multiple truckloads of gravel, each layer spread and compacted to ensure a solid foundation for the final step. The team of workers used asphalt pavers, hoppers, and steamrollers to give us our smooth surface, completed by painting lines, arrows, and even a crosswalk to achieve the beautiful final result.
