MCKENZIE BOUTTÉ, QDDP

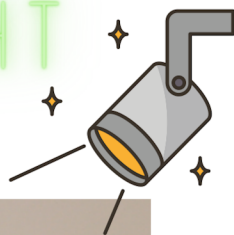
